Your RGNA Board is hard at work and doing its best to keep our neighborhood engaged even through Shelter-in-Place (SIP) orders.

This year we're setting up three celebration stations filled with fun things for kids and the young at heart.



Fourth of July Activity Station (1255 Forrestal) -Pickup your RGNA activity sheet after June 26; color them and tell us what 4th of July means to you.

Participants (<18) will receive a candy necklace. You'll need to drop them off by June 2 to receive your special candy necklace. All of the completed activity sheets will be featured on our website.

Flag/Pin Station (1381 Forrestal). Pick-up your flags and patriotic pins at the table in the driveway. First come first served, so make sure you get there early. Station opens at 10AM.



Bike Decorating Station (1255 Forrestal) - Patriotic packets will be ready for you to pickup and bring home to decorate your bike. Station opens at 10AM.

Lemonade and Popcorn Station (1312 San Pedro) -This station will also have a fun flag activity for you to put together. After you've picked up your flags and you've decorated your bike you should come by and treat yourself to some popcorn and lemonade for a job well done! Station will be open between 11AM - 2PM.

Each station will be adhering to SIP orders and we ask that you do the same.

Finally, we encourage all of our **RG Bike Riders to come out and show their bike decorations off at around 6PM.** Neighbors can sit in front of their homes to watch and wave their flags as the patriotic bike riders make their way through our streets.

Did You Know...?

 The 2020 Census is mandated by the Constitution and conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, a nonpartisan government agency. The 2020 Census counts the population in the United States and five U.S. territories (Puerto Rico, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, and the U.S. Virgin Islands). Each home has received an invitation to respond to a short questionnaire online, by phone, or by mail—between March 12-20. Participating in the census is required by law. A complete and accurate count is critical for you and your community, because the results of the 2020 Census will affect community funding, congressional representation, and more.
