With the help of volunteers, the Rosemary Gardens Neighborhood Association (RGNA) Board of Directors is proud to have organized many activities in 2017. Here is a look back:

- In February, we hosted our annual neighborhood association meeting, held our election of RGNA Board of Directors, and listened to presentations by representatives of both City and County Government.
- May, we worked with San José City Council District 3 to design a neighborhood welcome sign. Neighbors voted on three designs and made their final choice.
- In June, we joined our neighbors at our famous RGNA Yard Sale! The RGNA Board provided all



advertising and publicity at no charge to residents.

- August brought National Night Out to the park at Bachrodt Elementary School. It was wonderful to see so many neighbors chatting, eating ice cream, enjoying Cracker Jacks, and watching children blow bubbles and play games.
- September was a busy month starting with a neighborhood safety meeting. San José Police Department's Crime Prevention Unit gave an information-packed presentation that covered

personal, online and senior safety tips. The presenters graciously answered many questions.

- The ever-popular, much in demand Dumpster Day also took place in September. Neighbors with cars and trucks piled with lots of stuff filled seven dumpsters and several Goodwill boxes. Rosemary Gardens is a much tidier place now!
- In November, neighbors ordered their Christmas trees which were delivered directly to homes in December, courtesy of your RGNA Board of Directors!
- December ended the year with our first Rosemary Gardens Food Drive which was held between late November to mid-December and was a huge success! A total 485 pounds of food was donated, which equals 404 meals for those in need.
- The Rosemary Gardens Neighborly newsletter got back on track and was published on a quarterly basis in 2017, providing residents with information about happenings in Rosemary Gardens.
- RGNA Board utilized social media like Next Door and Facebook to keep residents updated on the Large Trash Capture Device Installation Project that disrupted the northern end of the neighborhood for many months.
